Stevens Athletics Week in Review

March 10, 2009

MEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record13-13
 Empire 8 record6-10

* Stevens men's basketball received a bid for the 2009 Eastern Collegiate Athletic Association Metro Tournament and fell in the opening round to the University of Rutgers-Newark in overtime by a 91-89 outcome.

* The Ducks held a 10-point lead with under four minutes to play in regulation but the Scarlet Raiders battled back to tie the score at 80 in the final seconds and went on to win it 91-89 with a put-back by junior forward Phil Barnes with two seconds to go overtime.

* Rutgers controlled the action early on, taking a 20-11 lead after a three-pointer from sophomore Kenny Widgeon midway through the first half. Stevens battled to tie the score at 24 with a 13-4 run over 3:21 of game time, and the Ducks (13-13 overall) went into the break with a 41-37 lead after a fast-break layup by senior captain **Michael Baker**.

* Stevens came out in the second half and controlled the action, building a 52-41 lead with 15:19 left. The Ducks kept the lead at or near double digits for the next five-plus minutes and took their largest advantage (12 points) after a layup by freshman guard **Michael Cutri**.

* Senior captain **Anthony Passalacqua** hit a three to put the Ducks up 70-60 with 3:45 to go, and it appeared they were in total control. However from that point on, the Scarlet Raiders went on to score 20 points in 3:33 to tie the score at 80 with three seconds to go. During that time the Ducks went 7-for-13 at the free-throw line and missed two in a row while up two with 16 seconds remaining.

* In the overtime, Stevens took an 82-80 lead after a Passalacqua layup, but Barnes responded by converting an old-fashioned three-point play to put Rutgers on top 83-82. The Scarlet Raiders went on to score five of the next seven points to build a four-point edge with 1:55 to play, but the Ducks did not go away. **Cutri** hit a triple to cut the lead to one and after Rutgers-Newark made one of their two free throws on the other end, **Baker** sliced through the lane and made a layup to tie the game at 89. That however would be all for the Ducks as Barnes was able to put back a missed layup by junior guard Tim Smith for the win.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record23-6
 Empire 8 record12-4

* The Stevens Institute of Technology women's basketball team made history having recorded its first-ever NCAA win in program history during the opening round against Mary Washington. The Ducks then took on NYU to fall in the second round and bring an end to a remarkable and legendary season for Stevens.

* Senior point guard **Dani Dudek** scored 12 second-half points to help lift the Stevens Institute of Technology women's basketball team to their first-ever NCAA win with a 59-50 victory over the University of Mary Washington in the opening round of the 2009 NCAA Division III Championship. The Ducks claimed a seven-point lead with less than two minutes to go in regulation. Sophomore center **Paige Armstrong** was unstoppable in the paint as she recorded her sixth double-double of the season on 13 points and 12 boards.

* The turning point came when junior forward **Brittany Fuller** hit her first three-pointer of the game to Stevens up by four (48-44) with 5:44 to go. **Armstrong** then added three more points on a layup and a free-throw to extend the lead to seven. Mary Washington tried to chip away, but the Ducks were resilient, having an answer for the offensive response of the Eagles. Dudek closed the game out with four free-throws in the final minute of play to secure the win and extend keep the Ducks' dream alive. The game featured four lead changes and was tied-up four separate times.

* The Ducks came within two points in the first half against NYU, but a late 14-4 run by the Violets in the second, helped to secure the win en route to its advancement to the Sweet 16. Sophomore center **Paige Armstrong** led the way with her seventh double-double of the season on 17 points and 10 rebounds. The Ducks finish the season 23-6 and wrapped up the 2008-09 campaign as the first team in Stevens women's basketball history to reach the NCAA Tournament. Stevens finished a win shy of tying the most wins in a season of 24.

* "There was a lot of adversity that this team overcame," said Head Coach Jon Hochberg. "There were many highs and lows, but the team never stopped competing; we tried to get better everyday. The tough games that we had we turned into a positive and learned from them as we carried it into post-season play. I am so proud of this team," added Hochberg.

Baseball

Overall record2-7

* The Stevens Institute of Technology baseball team went 1-2 on the week with a win over St. Joseph's College (L.I.). The Ducks swallowed a tough loss to the College of Mount St. Vincent as Stevens held a 6-4 lead through the two-thirds of the ninth to fall in the 11th 10-8.

* Junior outfielder **Russ Grimes** tallied four runs batted in and crossed the plate four times for the Ducks as Stevens defeated the College of Mount St. Vincent, 7-3 before it fell to St. Joseph's College (L.I.) 10-8 in extra innings on Sunday afternoon in Hoboken, N.J. Grimes launched his second homer of the game in the bottom half of the ninth to knot it at 8-all. However, a costly error in the top of the 11th allowed two runs to score for St. Joseph's as Stevens currently stands at 2-5 on the year.

* In the win over the Dolphins, sophomore infielder **Ken Meerendonk** took his turn on the hill as he pitched for six innings, having allowed just one earned. Meerendonk was stellar; in five innings he did not give up a single hit. He finished with six strikeouts in 23 batters faced. Sophomore pitcher **Kyle Hanas** closed out the game in the top of the ninth as he sat one batter down and did not allow a hit.

* Through six innings against the Mt. St. Vincent, the contest was tied-up at 4-all. Stevens then posted runs in the bottom half of the seventh and eighth to take a two-run lead. **Phillips** drove in junior infielder **Eddie Daniele** off a single through the left side of the infield in the seventh. **Grimes** scored in the eighth on a fielder's choice to give Stevens a slight advantage heading into the top of the ninth. With two outs and men on first and second, junior pitcher **Bill Jennings** gave up a three-run shot on a 2-2 count to give St. Joe's a one-run lead (8-7). The dinger was off the bat of sophomore outfielder Mike Lanza. The ensuing batter, senior infielder Jon Welsh blasted his second long ball of the game to pad the Golden Eagles' margin to two runs. With their backs against the wall, the Ducks needed an offensive response. **Phillips** started the inning off with a groundout to the first baseman. After a pitching change, **Meerendonk** went down on strikes. With two outs, sophomore catcher **Denis Ackermann** drew a walk as **Grimes** stepped to the plate. He dialed up his second homer of the game to tie it at 8-8. Stevens still had an opportunity to win the game as the Ducks left two men on base.

* Following a scoreless 10th inning, St. Joe's scored two runs in the top of the 11th to pull out the victory. With men on first and second, a groundball to the third baseman was fielder cleanly, however he attempted to tag the advancing runner, but missed and forced a quick throw to first that found the dead ball area.

* The women's swimming team did not compete this week but will return to action on at the NCAA Division III Championships hosted at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis, Minn.

* Late last week, the National Collegiate Athletic Association released its official psyche sheet for the upcoming 2009 NCAA Division III Swimming and Diving Championships and seven members of the Stevens Institute of Technology women's swimming team got the nod. Senior captain **Emily Woo**, sophomore **Laura Barito**, freshman **Sian Pearson**, freshman **Cailin Grunewald**, junior **Stephanie Miller**, freshman **Andrea Sturniolo**, and freshman **Hayley Hatfield** are the team members to get the invite as Stevens is sending the most team members to the championships in school history.

* **Woo** will swimming the 100-yard butterfly, 100-yard backstroke, the 200-, 400-, and 800-yard freestyle relays, and the butterfly leg in the 200- and 400-yard medley relays. Woo was selected to swim in the 200-yard individual medley but was scratched so she could compete in a fifth relay.

* **Barito** will compete in two individual events, the 50- and 100-yard freestyles. She is currently No. 6 in the country in the 50-free and No. 9 in the 100-free. She will also swim in the same five relays as Woo, and in the medley events she will swim the freestyle leg.

* **Pearson** will compete in the 200- and 500-yard freestyles and the 200-yard butterfly. The freshman is currently ranked No. 19 in the 200-butterfly and will also compete in the 800-yard freestyle relay. **Grunewald** will swim in the 100-, 200-, and 500-free events, in addition to the 200-, 400-, and 800-free relays.

* The sixth-ranked Stevens Institute of Technology men's volleyball team dropped a pair of matches on the week including a 3-1 loss to Division I foe Princeton University.

* Senior outside hitter **Joe Trinsey** tallied 19 kills and seven blocks as Stevens had its hands full with conference rival No. 6 Ramapo College Wednesday night in Mahwah, N.J. as the Ducks fell 30-27, 30-28, 31-29. Senior middle hitter **Doug Reger** notched a .583 hitting percentage on eight kills and landed five blocks as the Ducks drop to 16-4 on the year and 4-1 in NECBA Metro division play.

* Senior outside hitter **Tomas Bochicchio** posted 15 kills, three service aces and two blocks the Ducks lost a tough 3-1 match to Division I foe Princeton University Friday evening in Princeton, N.J. After claiming a win in Set 1, the Ducks fell by the scores of 30-27, 25-30, 28-30 and 24-30. The team produced a .244 hitting percentage and notched 13 team blocks as Stevens falls to 16-5 on the year.

* Senior outside hitter **Joe Trinsey** landed 14 kills a pair of aces and four total blocks, while senior middle hitter **Andrew Cranford** notched 10 kills, two aces and four blocks. Sophomore setter **Brandt Grobeis** dished out 47 assists as senior libero **Michael Ozols** led defensively with 10 digs. Bochicchio had 20 points on the night and lofted nine digs.

* The NCAA recently publicized its sixth national ranking summary for the 2009 men's volleyball season, and for the fifth week in a row, Stevens junior middle hitter **Andrew Cranford** leads the nation in hitting percentage (.497) through 67 sets played. He is also seventh for blocks per set (1.27) and 41st for kills per set (3.28). Senior outside hitter **Joe Trinsey** is listed among the Top-30 for a number of individual statistical categories. Senior middle hitter **Doug Reger** has maintained the top spot for blocks per game having averaged 1.65 per set. As a team, the Ducks are ranked within the Top-35 for every statistical category. Stevens sits atop of the ranks for blocks per game (3.76), while the Ducks are third in kills per game (15.35) and hitting percentage (0.322). Stevens is fifth for match win/loss percentage (0.762) for their overall mark of 16-5. Finally, Stevens is fourth for assists per game (14.28), 21st for digs per game (11.10) and 33rd for aces per game (1.31).

* Stevens Institute of Technology freshman **Ryan Dormann** closed out his season at the 2009 Division III Wrestling Championships. The 174-pounder went 1-2 overall but wrestled very well against some of the best wrestlers in the country at his weight. Dormann opened the tournament in the second round by falling to No. 2 Rocky Mantella of Delaware Valley College, 9-5. He rebounded in his second match of the day by defeating the seventh-ranked wrestler in the nation, Troy Carlson, before falling to Frank Heffernan of Wilkes University in his final match of the tournament.

* Dormann took on the undefeated Mantella and wrestled extremely well but could not get the points needed to win. The Delaware Valley standout ended up placing second.

* In the second match, Dormann dictated the action on the feet and did a nice job when on top to earn the impressive 5-4 decision over a very strong wrestler in Carlson on the University of Chicago.

* In the final bout versus Heffernan, Dormann put forth another great effort but fell just short, 2-0. After a scoreless first period, the Stevens rookie chose bottom and could not get out. Dormann cut Heffernan in early in the third to give him a 1-0 lead and could not get through his defense to get the take down he needed.

* Dormann is the second Stevens freshman to qualify for the NCAA's and first to win a match at the national tournament. His win was over the No. 7 seed and his two losses were against the second- and seventh-place finishers.

* "This was a great trip for Ryan," Head Wrestling Coach **Mike Clayton** said. "I know he is disappointed to have missed the award stand this year, but I'm sure he will use this experience as a driving force for his off-season training."
