Stevens Athletics Week in Review

Baseball

Overall record21-20
 Empire 8 record7-9

* Stevens finished 2009 with a record of 21-20. The Ducks reached the final of the 2009 ECAC Metro Tournament. They improved upon their 2008 wins by 11.

* Senior first baseman **Dan Silva** drove in the winning run with the bases loaded in the bottom half of the tenth inning as the Stevens Institute of Technology baseball team pulled out a 4-3 victory over the College of Mount St. Vincent during the first round of the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference Metro Division Championship Wednesday night in Hoboken, N.J. The Ducks were held to just two hits through five innings as both bullpens battled to keep their teams in it. Stevens came back to tie the game at 3-all off a three-run sixth inning. Freshman pitcher **Vincent Vinci** was called upon in the sixth and pitched five shutout innings having allowed just three hits, while striking out eight batters, en route to his second win of the season (2-3).

* Junior outfielder **Russ Grimes** blasted a solo home run in the top half of the 10th inning to lift the Stevens Institute of Technology baseball team over Rutgers University-Newark, 7-6 on Friday afternoon at Bear & Eagles Riverfront Stadium in Newark, N.J. The win moved the Ducks into the final of the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference Metro Tournament.

* Sophomore catcher **Denis Ackermann** batted 3-for-4 with a run scored and drove one in as the fourth-seeded Stevens Institute of Technology baseball team dropped the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference Metro Division Final on Saturday afternoon in Hoboken, N.J. to second-seeded Ramapo College in a 9-6 decision. The Roadrunners, who entered today's contest with a team total of nine homeruns, jacked five in the victory, which resulted in eight of their nine runs.

Men's Lacrosse

Overall record12-6
 Empire 8 record6-2

* The Stevens men's lacrosse team finished the 2009 season with a record of 12 -6.

* Sophomore **Dave Decker** was named the Empire 8 Goalkeeper of the Year.

* Senior attackman **Matt Keating** was named the Empire 8 Player of the Year.

* In addition to Keating and Decker, seniors **Alex Heckman** and **J.R. Oreskovich** were named first-team All-Empire 8.

* Sophomore **Zach McHugh** was a second-team all-conference selection, and sophomore Ted Pfeifer and junior Alex Couture were both honorable mention all-conference. Senior Burke Reynolds was the Empire 8 Sportsman of the Year for Stevens.

* Keating, Oreskovich, Heckman, McHugh, Decker, and senior **Eric Smith** were all named to the 2009 All-Metro Region Men's Lacrosse Team.

* Freshman **Alex Hofrichter** scored four goals and senior **J.R. Oreskovich** recorded four assists as the Stevens Institute of Technology men's lacrosse team dominated Kean University, 14-4 on Friday night at the De Baun Athletic Complex in an ECAC Metro/South Tournament semifinal. With the win, the Ducks advanced to Sunday's championship game.

* The outcome of this game was clear from the start as Empire 8 Player of the Year, **Matt Keating** put home the first of Oreskovich's four assists 24 seconds into the game. In the second half, Kean would never get closer than seven as Head Stevens Lacrosse Coach Byron Collins was able to use just about every available player he had.

* Junior captain **Bobby Steinhauser** won 18 of the 26 face-offs he took, sophomore goalkeeper **Dave Decker** made 17 saves, and senior attackman **J.R. Oreskovich** had five points as the Stevens Institute of Technology men's lacrosse team won the ECAC Metro/South title with a 15-9 win over Drew University on Sunday at the De Baun Athletic Complex in Hoboken, N.J. The Ducks scored the game's first seven goals and were never threatened en route to their 12th win of the season. Stevens dominated the contest from the start, ending with a 54-38 advantage in shots and a 41-33 edge in ground balls. The Ducks won 18-of-27 face-offs and converted 12-of-14 clears.

* The MVP finished the contest with 18 face-offs won, three caused turnovers, and a season-high 12 ground balls. He also recorded an assist.

Women's Lacrosse

Overall record16-2
 Empire 8 record8-0

* The Stevens women's lacrosse team ended the year with a 16-2 overall record. They are currently ranked 14th in the country.

* The No. 14 Stevens Institute of Technology women's lacrosse team rolled to its second consecutive ECAC Metro/South Tournament championship on Sunday afternoon with a 21-12 win over Fairleigh Dickinson University-Florham. Senior captain **Cassidy Callahan** was named the game's Most Valuable Player and sophomore **Leah Wasserman** paced the Stevens attack, recording seven points on five goals and two assists. The win marks the end of the 2009 season.

* Sophomore **Christine Smith** put the Ducks on top 12 seconds into the game, taking the opening draw and netting the contest's first shot. Junior **Alyssa Pigott** (2), sophomore **Karen Federico**, and junior **Fionuala Quinn** all tallied goals over the next 10-plus minutes to put Stevens up 5-0 with 19:22 to go in the first.

* Stevens came out strong in the second half, scoring three-straight times in just 1:23 take its largest lead of the game (12-6). Sophomore Lindsey Parent stopped the bleeding for the Devils and they were able to cut the lead to four with 25:03 to play, but the Ducks quickly answered back.

* This time it was four consecutive scores in a span 6:23 to put the game away. Smith started and ended the run as Wasserman and sophomore **Pam Loria** also registered goals.

* Stevens' largest lead of the game was 10 after Pigott tallied with 10:00 remaining to make the score 21-11. Stevens finished with a 49-26 advantage in shots and a 25-17 edge in ground balls. The Ducks won 20-of-35 draw controls and went 3-for-7 on free-position shots. Senior goalkeeper **Grace Sack** made 12 saves to earn the win in goal. Her opposite, senior Christine Dunn, made 11 saves in the loss.

* Pigott finished her superb season with four goals and two assists. She totaled 97 points in 18 games and is currently second all-time in points at Stevens. Federico and Smith each tallied three times and recorded one assist. Smith also had five draw controls. Quinn had a season-high three goals and picked up three ground balls in addition to controlling two draws. Senior **Ali Palen** caused two turnovers and scooped up one ground ball in her final game as a Duck. Loria had three goals and two ground balls, and junior **Kara Borzillo** caused a turnover, controlled two draws, picked up two ground balls, and added an assist.

* Wasserman was huge all afternoon, scoring five goals, notching two assists, corralling two draws, picking up two ground balls, and causing two Devil turnovers. The championship game's MVP, Cassidy Callahan, played a great all-around game for the Stevens defense. She had a game-high six ground balls, caused four turnovers, and had four draw controls.
