WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record9-2
 Empire 8 record1-1

* The Stevens Institute of Technology women's basketball team earned its ninth win of the season with a 90-75 victory over SUNY New Paltz last Wednesday night.

* Senior guard **Dani Dudek** posted her fifth double-double of the season on 24 points and 11 rebounds. Her performance garnered Empire 8 Player of the Week honors for the second time this season. In addition, she earned her first Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference Division III Upstate Player of the Week accolade. Dudek finished the game 8-of-13 from the field and was 8-of-11 from the line. In the third NCAA Statistical release, Dudek is number two in the country for assists per game (7.8) and is 22nd in assist-turnover ratio (2.05).

* This week, the Ducks are ranked within the Top-50 in six national statistical categories by the NCAA. Stevens is in the top of the ranks for scoring margin (38th), field-goal percentage (30th), field-goal percentage defense (24th), win-loss percentage (36th), assists per game (30th), assist turnover ratio (12th). Stevens has posted a scoring margin of 14.7 over its opponents. The Ducks are shooting 43.8 percent from the floor, while holding the opposition to an average field-goal percentage of 32.7. Stevens has recorded an assist per game average of 16.5. The Ducks have produced a win-loss percentage of 81.8 with their 9-2 overall record.

* Junior guard **Sarah Gehring** was five of nine from behind the arc as she tallied 22 points in the win over the Hawks. On the year, Gehring has knocked down a total of 14 three-pointers.

* Junior forward **Brittany Fuller** is currently second on the team in points (128) as she is shooting 40.2 percent from the floor. She is also 25-for-61 from three-point range.

* Sophomore center **Paige Armstrong** leads the squad in rebounds (93) as she is averaging 8.5 per contest. She has one of the highest field goal percentages (58.9) as she is shooting 43 of 73.

Women's Indoor Track & Field

* Four Stevens Institute of Technology school records fell on Friday evening at the New York University Open Invitational. Senior **Salme Cook** set a new school mark in the 600-meter run and was part of two record-breaking relays. Senior **Hillary Paul** was also part of the record-setting relays in her first-ever collegiate meet, and junior **Melissa Franzese** bested her own school mark in the 3k. Stevens was scheduled to compete at the United States Military Academy Invitational on Saturday but did not because of snow.

* Cook turned in a 1:42.44 in the 600 and bested the previous record by 15 seconds. Franzese's 10.48.76 in the 3k was good for fifth overall and also made her the first women's athlete to qualify for the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference Championships.

* The sprint medley relay squad that broke one of the two relay records was made up of Cook, sophomores **Caroline Pawalowski** and **Shanna Beirsto**, and Paul. They turned in a time of 4:33.32. Cook, Paul, Beirsto, and Pawalowski also combined to break the school mark in the 4X400-meter relay, carding a time of 4:21.34.

Men's Indoor Track & Field

* The Stevens Institute of Technology men's indoor track and field team competed at the New York University Open Invitational on Friday evening at the New York Armory. The Ducks broke two school records at the meet, and senior **Trevor Currie** was the first Duck to turn in an Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference qualifying time. Stevens was scheduled to compete at the United States Military Academy Meet on Saturday but did not because of snow in the north-east.

* Currie broke the former school record in the pole vault, clearing 4.40-meters, coming in second overall, and qualifying for the ECAC's. He also posted the best split in the 4x400-meter relay (51.8 seconds).

* The 1600-meter medley relay squad of freshmen **Greg McLeod** and **Rich Fox**, junior **John Sangiovanni**, and sophomore **Michael Pawalowski** also set a new school record with a time of 3:46.25.

* Sophomore **Bradford Antes** turned in a personal-best time in the mile, carding a 4:40.26, and rookie **Andrew Verderame** ran the best 3k in his career by 17 seconds (9:55.70).

* Stevens will now return to action at another NYU Open Invitational on Friday, January 16.
