Stevens Athletics Week in Review

January 20, 2009

MEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record10-5
 Empire 8 record3-3

* Stevens went 3-0 in Empire 8 play this past week and is now 3-3 in the conference and 10-5 overall.

* Freshman forward Simon Smith scored 22 points and pulled down 12 rebounds, and senior guard **Anthony Passalacqua** scored a game-high 23 points to lead the Stevens past Alfred University, 75-67 on Friday night in Alfred, N.Y. at the McLane Center. The win was the first in the Empire 8 for the Ducks who had lost their three previous conference contests.

* The Stevens-Elmira game on Sunday night was postponed because Canavan Arena was unplayable. The game was rescheduled and played on Monday.

* Stevens defeated Elmira College, 70-63 on Monday evening in Union, N.J. at Kean University. The win was the second in a row for Stevens who had lost its previous three games. The Ducks are now 2-3 in the Empire 8 and 9-5 overall. Freshman **Eric Kessler** provided the Ducks with a big lift off the bench, hitting four from long range, three of which came during a huge 23-5 second-half run. The game was tied at 26-all when the teams returned to the floor after halftime. Senior guard **Anthony Passalacqua** hit a three 14 seconds in, but Elmira responded with a 9-0 run to take a 35-29 lead with 17:44 remaining. From that point on, the Ducks proceeded to score 23 of game's next 28 points to take a commanding, 52-40 lead with a little less than 10 minutes to play. Kessler brought the Ducks within one at 35-34 at the 15:47 mark and gave Stevens the lead for good when he buried another from long range on a nice feed from Passalacqua. The run was capped by traditional three-point play by freshman forward **Simon Smith**, who played a strong second half after being forced to sit out much of the first because of foul trouble.

* Senior tri-captains **Anthony Passalacqua** and **Virgil Gray** combined for 32 points as Stevens evened its conference record at 3-3 with a 60-52 win over Hartwick College on Tuesday evening in Hoboken, N.J. at the Canavan Arena. Stevens has now won three-straight Empire 8 games. The Ducks were able to shoot 52.4 percent from the floor in the game's final 20 minutes to help secure the victory.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record13-2
 Empire 8 record5-1

* The Stevens Institute of Technology women's basketball team went 4-0 in the week having earned conference wins over Utica College, Alfred University, Elmira College and including its most recent win over Hartwick College.

* The Ducks are currently 13-2 on the year and 5-1 in Empire 8 play.

* Senior point guard Dani Dudek led the way as she totaled 62 points in four games for an average of 15.5 points per contest. She dished out 22 assists and pulled down 31 boards. Against Utica and Hartwick, she recorded her sixth and seventh double-double of the season. Dudek was a rebound she of capturing her fifth career triple-double against the Hawks.

* Junior forward **Brittany Fuller** tallied 58 points for a 14.5 points per game average. She notched 31 rebounds and was seven of 26 from three-point land. Fuller shot 40 percent from the floor on 24 of 60 shooting.

* Junior guard **Sarah Gehring** was 10 of 23 from behind the arc as she accumulated 34 points in 123 minutes played. She recorded 18 rebounds and 12 assists.

* Freshman forward **Jillian Barrett** was 16 of 30 from the field for a 53.3 shooting proficiency. She had 38 points and tallied 21 boards, seven offensive 14 defensive. Barrett also had a pair of blocked shots during the week. Freshman guard **Dawn Garcia** was 6-for-16 from downtown and had 30 points off the bench.

* Sophomore center **Paige Armstrong** saw 69 minutes of action this week as she knocked down 16 baskets and pulled in 26 rebounds. She is the third member of the team to register 34 points in the four victories recorded.

Sticco came off the bench to replace two starters and went 14-2 on the day as the Ducks posted a win against Division I Fairleigh Dickinson University (18-9).

* Stevens also took on the likes of Division II opponents; the University Detroit and Queens College to earn a pair of victories, both by 26-6 outcomes. Stevens also earned two more victories over the City College of New York (18-9) and New Jersey Institute of Technology (24-3). The Ducks stand at 7-1 in dual performances, after their flawless outing yesterday.

* The sabre team had a great day for Stevens. Senior **Laura Sodon** went 16-2, while junior **Erica Mondadori** posted a 13-3 showing.

Women's Indoor Track & Field

* On Friday, senior **Salme Cook** of the Stevens Institute of Technology women's indoor track and field team met the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference qualifying standard and set a Stevens best in the 500-meter dash on Friday evening at the Gotham Invitational in New York, N.Y. Cook broke the previous record of 1:24.57, which she held for a year, after having clocked a 1:20.51 during yesterday's competition. In addition, she just met the ECAC qualifying standard of 1:21.67 as well.

* Two other school records were established in the 800-meter run and the Distance Medley Relay.

* Sophomore **Shanna Beirsto** established a school-best in the 800-meter run when she crossed the line in 2:28.79. She surpassed the previous mark by over seven seconds, when former standout Sara Amitrani posted a time of 2:36.18 at the 2008 Army Open.

This mark was over 10 seconds faster than the previous Stevens record of 13:37.46, established by Amitrani, Cook, Franzese and sophomore Jamie Brabston during last season's Empire 8 Championship.

* The Stevens-Western New England match started at the 157-lb. weight class where junior **Leo Dormann** won by forfeit, and freshman **Joe Favia** defeated Ted Banks in a 6-4 decision at 165 lbs. Senior **Jordan Chacon** rolled over Travone Logan 13-4 at 174 lbs. Freshman **Ryan Dormann** won by forfeit at 184 lbs. and senior **Valentin Riazanov** defeated David Baldyga in the 197-lb. weight class. Junior **James Roarty** took a 9-4 decision over Dan Pastiga at 285, and both **Frank Maselli** and senior captain **Mark Bistis** were winners by forfeit at 125 lbs. and 133 lbs., respectively. Senior captain **Pat Conrad** pinned Ryan Komich at 6:19, and **Tony Mancini** won a tight 4-1 match in the 149-lb weight class over Steve Lauzon to round out the scoring. The 46-0 shutout of WNEC is the second shutout of the season for the Ducks as they held Yeshiva scoreless for their first win of 2008.
