Stevens Athletics Week in Review

January 27, 2009

MEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record10-7
 Empire 8 record3-5

* The Stevens Institute of Technology men's basketball team went 1-2 last week in Empire 8 play. The Ducks are now 2-2 on their seven-game homestand.

* Senior tri-captains **Anthony Passalacqua** and **Virgil Gray** combined for 32 points as the Stevens Institute of Technology men's basketball team evened its conference record at 3-3 with a 60-52 win over Hartwick College on Tuesday evening at the Canavan Arena. The Ducks were able to shoot 52.4 percent from the floor in the game's final 20 minutes to help secure the victory. With the Hawks holding a 32-29 lead with 15:37 to go, Passalacqua was able to hit one of two technical free throws to slow the momentum, and Gray then converted a dunk after a steal to ignite the crowd and tie the game. The two teams went back and forth for the next five minutes before Stevens was able to build a 54-39 lead with a 14-0 explosion that came out of the nowhere. The run started and ended with Gray who had seven of the 14 points on three jumpers and a free throw.

* Men's basketball fell in a heartbreaker to Rochester Institute of Technology, 56-55 on Friday night. The Ducks battled all night but came up just short in the closing seconds to the Empire 8's first-place team. Senior tri-captain **Virgil Gray** became the school's all-time leading scorer with a runner in the lane late in the second half. Gray finished with a game-high 20 points on 8-for-18 from the field. He scored his 1,563rd point to break the record that was formerly held by 2008 graduate **Waleed Farid**.

* The Ducks dropped a heartbreaker on Sunday at the hands of the second-place team in the conference, Ithaca College, 84-80. The Ducks held the lead for much of the second half, but Ithaca battled and made some big shots late to secure the win. Stevens was led by 23 points, six assists, and five rebounds from senior guard **Michael Baker**. With 11:45 to go in the second half and Ithaca on top 55-51, the Ducks exploded on the offensive end of the floor with a 17-3 run to build a 68-58 lead with 6:37 remaining in the contest. Senior guard **Anthony Passalacqua** had nine points to key the run. Trailing by one with less than a minute to play, Baker was able to hit a three from the left side as the shot clock expired to put the Ducks up one (78-77), but senior guard Sean Burton canned two free throws the following trip down the floor to put Ithaca up for good. The Bombers went 5-for-6 from the charity stripe over the final 42 seconds to help seal the win.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record14-3
 Empire 8 record6-2

* The Stevens Institute of Technology women's basketball team posted a conference victory against Rochester Institute of Technology before the Ducks fell in a tight battle against Ithaca College, which is currently atop of the Empire 8.

* Senior guard **Dani Dudek** posted her fifth career triple-double on 17 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists to help Stevens earn its sixth conference win of the year and sixth-straight victory as the Ducks defeated RIT on Friday night. Dudek was six of 15 from the field, dished out six assists and pulled down eight boards in the loss to Ithaca.

* **Dani Dudek's** 10 assists against the Tigers surpassed the 600 career-assist mark as she stands at 607. She now joins Division I legends *Nancy Liberman, Dawn Staley* and *Kelly Miller* to have scored 1,000-plus points, pulled down 700-plus boards and dished out 600-plus assists. Dudek is the first-ever known Division III basketball player to have accomplished this feat.

* Junior forward **Brittany Fuller** tallied 28 points on 12 of 22 shooting in the win over the Tigers. She added eight rebounds for Stevens. Against Ithaca, Fuller led the way with her 28 points on 12 of 22 shooting.

* Junior guard **Sarah Gehring** surpassed the 100 career three-point field-goal plateau against RIT, as she notched 15 points after Gehring landed three three-point field-goals to bring her career total to 101.

* Sophomore center **Paige Armstrong** had 10 points and was flawless from the field on five of five shooting against the Tigers. She had eight total rebounds as well.

* Freshman forward **Jillian Barrett** pulled in seven boards and posted seven points against RIT. In the loss to Ithaca, Barrett led the Ducks in total rebounds (11), tallied seven points and posted four blocks.

* The Ducks will host Nazareth College on Friday at 6 p.m. in their fifth-straight home-contest.

Women's Indoor Track & Field

* Senior **Salme Cook** posted a pair of individual school records and combined for one along with the rest of the women's 4x400 relay team as the Stevens Institute of Technology women's indoor track and field squad had a solid showing Saturday at the Wesleyan University Meet in Middletown, Conn. Cook set a Stevens best in the 200- and 400-meter dashes, in addition to having finished first in each of the events.

* Sophomore **Chika Ekwegariri** set a school record in the 55-meter dash with her time of 7.80. She surpassed the previous time of 8.07, established by Efe Kragha at the Collegiate Track Championships back in February of 1999. Cook clocked a time of 27.57 in the 200, then came back to card a 1:01.30 clocking in the 400-meter dash. She was the previous record holder for both events, having improved on her times of 28.61 and 1:02.38. Sophomore **Caroline Pawalowski** posted a school-best in the triple jump with her leap of 9.91 meters (32'6"). She surpassed the previous mark of 9.49 meters (31'1") set by Sunny Kennedy at the New York City Armory in February of 2000.

* The Ducks received a solid outing from their freshmen. **Alina Duran** set a Stevens record in the shot put with her heave of 9.96 meters (32'8"). Her throw was five inches further than the previous mark of 9.84 (32'3") set on December 5, 1999 by Monica Johnson. **Grace Python** carded a school record in the weight throw with her toss of 10.37 meters (34'). She improved on the old record of 8.83 (28'11") established by Johnson nine years ago, by over five feet. Then **Amethyst Holder** finished first and recorded a time of 9.34. Her mark sets a Stevens best as it surpasses the previous record of 10.13 set by Kristen Wolf in February of 2006.

* The 4x4 team of Cook, Ekwegariri senior **Hillary Paul** and sophomore **Shanna Beairsto** all combined for a school best with their time of 4:21.32. They improved on their previous time by two-hundredths of a second. Beairsto also notched a first-place finish in the 600-meter run with her time of 1:47.54.

* Stevens will return to action at the Empire 8 Championships next Sunday held in Rochester, N.Y. scheduled for a 10 a.m. start.

Overall record 8-7
 Centennial Conference 2-1

* The Stevens Institute of Technology wrestling team continued its strong second semester on Saturday at the Canavan Arena in Hoboken, N.J. The Ducks hosted a Centennial Conference Quad and went 2-1 overall to improve to 8-7 on the season. Stevens opened the day with a convincing, 36-6 win over Washington & Lee University and followed that up with a solid, 27-20 victory over McDaniel College. The Ducks fell in the day's finale to the United States Merchant Marine Academy but had several individuals shine in the final match.

* The Ducks were impressive in their opening match of the day as they rolled over Washington & Lee. Senior captain **Mark Bistis** got the Ducks on the board at 133 lbs. with a major decision over Sam Campbell. **Robert W. Bolomey III** followed Bistis with a 15-9 decision at 141 lbs. to give Stevens a 7-3 lead. After dropping a match in the 149-lb. weight class, junior **Leo Dormann** won by pin fall at 157 lbs. to put Stevens on top 13-6. Freshman **Joe Favia** followed with a decision at 165, and fellow freshman **Ryan Dormann** pinned Rob Terrin 1:45 into the match to give the Ducks a big, 22-6 lead. Both Leo and Ryan Dormann have been wrestling very well of late. Senior **Jordan Chacon** earned the third Stevens pin fall victory of the opening match at 184 lbs., and sophomore **Vincent Termini** gave the Ducks a 33-6 lead with a technical fall win in the 197-lb. weight class. Junior **James Roarty** continued his solid season with a 3-1 decision over John Christopher at 285 lbs to close out the match.

* Match number two saw McDaniel take an early 4-0 lead, but Bistis came back to win his second match of the day by pin fall at 2:39 to put the Ducks ahead 6-4. Bolomey put the Ducks up 9-4 after a decision in the 141-lb. weight class but, Brent Lowe put McDaniel back on top, 10-9 with a pin of junior **Tony Mancini** at 149 lbs. Leo Dormann got his second-straight win by pin fall at 157 lbs. and Favia earned a hard-fought decision at 165. Ryan Dormann earned a win by forfeit in the 174-lb. weight class to give the Ducks a commanding 24-10 lead, and Chacon won by decision (3-2) in a battle with Ferris Bond at 184 lbs. McDaniel came back to win the final two bouts but it was too little too late as Stevens was able to hang on for the 27-20 win and a 2-0 start to the Centennial Conference season.

* The Ducks fell in the day's final match to the United States Merchant Marine Academy, 25-16. However, after falling down 20-0 after two losses by pin fall and two by major decision, the Stevens wrestlers made a comeback and showed a lot of heart. Leo Dormann won 6-0 over Scott Lowe to improve to 3-0 on the day and get Stevens on the board. After Favia dropped a tough one at 165 lbs., Ryan Dormann defeated Erik Schott in a 3-0 decision to move his record to 3-0. Termini followed the younger Dormann's victory with an extremely impressive, 11-0 major decision at 184 lbs., and Roarty pinned James Billings (Washington, D.C.) in the final bout of the day. Stevens scored 16 of the final 22 points in the match.
