Stevens Athletics Week in Review

February 17, 2009

## MEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record . . . . .12-11  
 Empire 8 record . . . . .5-9

\* The Stevens Institute of Technology men's basketball team went 0-3 last week to fall to 5-9 in the Empire 8. Stevens could be officially eliminated from conference tournament contention depending on what St. John Fisher College does in its game Tuesday evening

\* Senior guard **Virgil Gray** scored 25 points and grabbed three rebounds, but it was not enough as the Stevens Institute of Technology men's basketball team fell to eighth-ranked Ithaca College, 81-68 on Tuesday evening at Ben Light Gymnasium in Ithaca, N.Y. The loss snapped a two-game conference winning streak for Stevens.

\* Men's basketball fell to 5-8 in the Empire 8 and 12-10 overall with a 74-68 loss to Rochester Institute of Technology on Friday night at Clark Gym in Rochester, N.Y. Four Ducks scored in double figures, but it was not enough to overcome the conference's first-place team, RIT. Senior forward Mark Carson led all players with 22 points and 12 rebounds as he also had four steals to go along with three blocks.

\* Stevens got several strong performances in the loss and hung with an RIT team that is 12-1 in conference play and 17-5 overall. Senior guard **Virgil Gray** netted 20 points and senior **Michael Baker** recorded his second double-double of the season with 14 points and 11 rebounds to go along with five assists. Senior guard **Anthony Passalacqua** and junior guard **Matt Higgins** had 12 points apiece as Stevens shot 46 percent from the field for the game.

\* A big difference in a very close game was at the free-throw line. Stevens went 7-for-18 from the stripe (3-for-13 in the second half), and RIT hit 16 of its 20 attempts.

\* Freshman forward **Simon Smith** did all he could but it was not enough as the Utica College Pioneers defeated Stevens, 69-64 in an Empire 8 game at Canavan Arena on Sunday afternoon in Hoboken, N.J. Smith scored 18 points on 8-for-9 from the floor and grabbed 15 rebounds in the loss as senior Doug Herring led Utica with 25 points and five rebounds.

\* Utica ended the game on a 6-0 run after Smith gave Stevens a one-point lead with a little more than one minute on the clock. Smith made one of two from the free-throw line after a put-back attempt.

\* Stevens will return to the hardwood on Friday when it visits Elmira College at 8 p.m.

## WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record . . . . .18-5  
 Empire 8 record . . . . .10-4

\* The Stevens Institute of Technology women's basketball team posted a 1-2 week, including its 18th win of the season over Utica. With the victory over the Pioneers, the Ducks have secured themselves a spot in the Empire 8 Championship.

\* With 14 seconds remaining, the Ducks watched their two-point advantage slip away when the Bombers nailed their ninth three-pointer of the contest to grab its only lead of the second half. Stevens had two attempts in the final seconds, however could not convert

\* Having trailed the entire game against RIT the Ducks took their only lead with 29 seconds to go up by one (62-61). However, the Tigers responded after a timeout with some nifty passing under the basket to regain the advantage with eight seconds remaining. Freshman guard **Melissa Collier** tried to win it for Stevens in the final seconds, but her jumper sailed just right of the rim.

\* Senior point guard **Dani Dudek** tallied 51 points, 25 rebounds and 14 assists on the week. She surpassed 800 career rebounds with her nine boards against Utica. Dudek joins Division I legend Nancy Leiberman as the only women's basketball players in NCAA history to have surpassed 1,000 career points, 800 rebounds and 600 assists.

\* Freshman guard **Melissa Collier** came up huge for the Ducks in their win over the Pioneers. In the final five minutes, Collier tallied seven points off of four-straight free-throws. With 28 seconds left in the game, Collier nailed a seven foot jumper to extend Stevens' lead to five as the Ducks carried on to victory.

\* Junior forward **Brittany Fuller** totaled 27 points on 10 of 30 shooting. She drained four three-balls on the week and pulled in 27 boards to lead the team in rebounding.

\* The NCAA recently announced its first 2009 regional poll and the Stevens is slotted third in the east region. This is the highest regional ranking Stevens has ever received. The Ducks will be back in action at Elmira on Friday at 6 p.m.

\* The Stevens Institute of Technology baseball team dropped a pair of games to start the 2009 season to nationally ranked Salisbury University Sunday afternoon.

\* Junior centerfielder **Mark Rasulo** was 5-for-7 on the day with three runs scored.

\* Both sophomore catcher **Denis Ackermann** and junior outfielder **Russ Grimes** tallied two runs batted in.

\* Stevens was held just to four hits in Game 1 of the twin bill.

\* Junior pitcher **Joe Finora** was tagged with the loss for his three and one-third innings pitched in Game 1. He sat down a pair of batters and gave up six earned runs.

\* Game 2 was knotted at 5-all after the Sea Gulls recorded three runs in the bottom of the fourth. Salisbury posted two more in the bottom half of the six as the Gulls kept Stevens scoreless over the final four innings.

\* **Mark Rasulo** led having gone 3-for-4 with two runs scored and an RBI. **Russ Grimes** plated a pair of runs as **T.J. Alcorn** recorded two hits in his first start behind the plate.

\* Sophomore outfielder **Matty Roman** started the top of the third off with a single up the middle. The following batter, freshman second baseman **Tom Phillips** drew a walk. The hot bat of **Rasulo** lined a single into left field for an RBI as Roman was waved home. An infield single by sophomore **Ken Meerendonk** loaded the bases for **Grimes**, who launched a single down the right-field line to score two runners. After a pitching change by Salisbury, freshman infielder **T.J. Alcorn** notched his first collegiate hit to plate Meerendonk for the fifth run of the inning.

\* Making his first collegiate start on the hill, freshman **John Watters** threw for three innings, allowed two earned runs and struck out three batters. However, it was freshman pitcher **Vincent Vinci** that was carded with the loss. He came in when the game was tied and gave up a pair of runs in three innings of work.

The Ducks will have one more competition before the NCAA's, in which Stevens will partake in the National Intercollegiate Women's Fencing Association Championships on February 28.

## Women's Indoor Track & Field

\* The Stevens Institute of Technology women's indoor track and field team set three new school-records over the weekend at the Collegiate Track Conference Championships in Middletown, Conn. Sophomore **Shanna Beairsto** shattered the previous program-mark in the 1000-meter run and two more relay records fell as the Ducks placed seventh of 19 total teams at the CTC's. Richard Stockton College won the event with a team total of 122 points as Rowan University was second and Mansfield University was third.

\* Bearisto shattered the former record in the 1000 by more than 10 seconds as she carded a 3:15.30 and finished in fourth-place overall, earning five points towards the team total of 58. One of the two relay records to fall was in the 4x200. Sophomore **Chika Ekweghariri**, freshman **Amethyst Holder**, sophomore **Caroline Pawalowski**, and sophomore **Lauren Griggs** combined to break the tape at 1:59.88, more than 15 seconds better than the previous record set at the 2002 CTC's.

\* The other record-breaking relay was the 4x800. The group of seniors **Salme Cook** and **Hillary Paul**, Beairsto, and junior **Melissa Franzese** finished the event in second place with a time of 10:17.18. The previous record, set back in 2007, was 11:12.78. Cook and Paul also took first and second in the 500-meter run, finishing with times of 1:20.99 and 1:22.46, respectively.

\* Franzese was a winner in the 5000-meter run as she turned in a time of 18:54.61 and earned the team 10 points. She was more than two seconds better than her closest competitor. Holder also had a solid individual finish in the 55-meter hurdles, placing fourth (9.36), and junior **Laura Goodman** cleared 1.48 meters in the high jump, good for third. Pawalowski triple jumped 9.80 meters in taking fifth overall.

\* Stevens will return to action at the New York University Last Chance Meet on February 27.

\* Sophomore outside hitter **SteFAn PremDas** totaled 24 kills, four aces and five blocks as the Ducks defeated No. 11 Carthage College then No. 13 Eastern Mennonite University. He notched a .450 hitting percentage, which was a team-high in the win over EMU. Building off of his performance in Day 1 of the Nazareth Tournament, PremDas returned to the court and posted a team-high 14 kills against New Paltz. PremDas continued his stellar play as he drilled nine kills, posted five blocks and four digs in the 3-0 win over the Mavericks.

\* Senior middle hitter **Andrew Cranford** produced a .437 hitting percentage over the five matches with 53 kills on 103 swings with just eight errors. He landed five service aces, lofted 15 digs and tallied 21 blocks.

\* Five different wrestlers went 2-0 on the day as the Stevens Institute of Technology wrestling team earned two wins to close out its regular-season schedule on Saturday afternoon at Gettysburg College. The Ducks defeated host Gettysburg in first match of the day, 36-13, and closed out the action with a 33-12 victory over Johns Hopkins University. Senior **Mark Bistis**, junior **Tony Mancini**, sophomore **Robert W. Bolomey III**, freshman **Joe Favia**, and freshman **Ryan Dormann** all recorded two wins in helping Stevens improve to 12-8 overall and 6-1 in the Centennial Conference.

\* Stevens fell behind 4-0 after a major decision for the Bullets at 125 lbs. but quickly came back to take over the match. Bistis earned a win by pin-fall at 133 to put Stevens on top for good at 6-4. He pinned freshman Michael Slabinski at 2:17 of the first period. Bolomey pinned sophomore Jack Bostrom at 4:40 he second period to give the Ducks an eight-point lead and Mancini earned a win by forfeit in the 149-lb weight class. After Gettysburg got a win by fall at 157 lbs., Favia recorded a technical fall over Anthony Iorio (19-4) to give Stevens a big, 23-10 lead. **Ryan Dormann** followed with a 12-4, major decision win at 174 lbs. and sophomore **Vincent Termini** won a close match at 184 lbs. Termini was a victor over sophomore Luke Mitchell, 6-2. Senior **Valentin Riazanov** pinned Jon Paul at 2:50 of the first to give the Ducks their final points of the match.

\* After falling behind for the second-straight match after the first bout, Bistis put the Ducks back on top. The senior won by forfeit at 133 lbs. to give Stevens a 6-3 lead and once again, the Ducks would not look back as they rolled to an easy win. Bolomey followed Bistis' forfeit victory with one of his own at 141 lbs., and Mancini earned solid victory over senior Mike Vechchiollo, 13-6 to put the Ducks on top 15-3. **Leo Dormann** earned his lone win of the day by pinning freshman Will Selba just 44 seconds into the bout, and Favia notched his second victory of the afternoon with an 11-5 decision over sophomore Eric Levenseller in the 165-lb. weight class. Ryan Dormann won by forfeit at 174 lbs. to give Stevens an insurmountable, 30-3 lead. Hopkins came back to win the next two matches at 184 and 197, but junior **James Roarty** won the final dual of the day, 6-2 over rookie Alex Villa.

\* Both Leo and Ryan Dormann finish the conference season undefeated as Stevens was 6-1 in the Centennial Conference.

\* The Ducks will return to mat on Saturday at the Centennial Conference Championships.
