Stevens Athletics Week in Review

February 10, 2009

MEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record12-8
 Empire 8 record5-6

* The Stevens Institute of Technology men's basketball went 1-0 last week.

* Senior guard **Anthony Passalacqua** was named the Empire 8 Men's Basketball Player of the Week on Monday morning.

* On the same night he was honored for scoring his 1,000th career point, senior guard **Anthony Passalacqua** set a new school-record for career three-point field goals made and propelled his team to a much-needed, 71-69 win over Alfred University. Passalacqua went 7-for-13 from long range and scored a game-high 23 points as the Ducks improved to 12-8 overall and 5-6 in the Empire 8. Passalacqua's fifth three of the night gave him 212 for his career, one better than 2001 graduate Christian Gavina.

* Stevens and Alfred were even at 59-59 with 5:26 to go. Trailing by one with 2:37 remaining, sophomore Mike Stopera hit a three, and Alfred took over the lead at 69-67.

* That lead was short lived as Passalacqua saved his biggest three of the night for his last. This one was after a nice feed from senior guard **Michael Baker**, and it gave Stevens the lead for good at 70-69 with 1:34 to go.

* Passalacqua finished with 23 points and six rebounds in 31 minutes. Senior guard **Virgil Gray** had a solid game as well for the Ducks, scoring 17 points and dishing out two assists. Baker finished with eight points, four rebounds, 10 assists, and three steals. Freshman **Michael Cutri** hit two big triples for Stevens and grabbed two rebounds, and junior forward **Ian Masone** was all over the court in his 28 minutes, totaling four points, three rebounds, two assists, a block and a steal. Freshman forward **Simon Smith** finished with four points and a team-high seven rebounds.

* Stevens visits No. 8 Ithaca College on Tuesday night at 8 p.m. and Rochester Institute of Technology on Friday night. Stevens returns home on Sunday, February 15 to host Utica College in the final home game of the season. Stevens will honor its three senior captains before the game and it will also be Duckling Day at Canavan Arena.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall record17-3
 Empire 8 record9-2

* Junior forward **Brittany Fuller** landed 10 points and pulled in 12 boards to help the Stevens Institute of Technology women's basketball to their ninth Empire 8 win of the year in a 59-52 victory over Alfred University last Friday.

* Ahead by one (53-52) with just over a minute in regulation, **Brittany Fuller** came up with a huge block for a turnover, which the Ducks converted into a three-point play to go up by four en route to their 17th win of the season.

* Stevens shot 36.8 percent from the floor, while the Saxons posted a 32.8 shooting percentage on the night. The Ducks out-rebounded Alfred 45-36 and scored 20 points from inside the box, while the bench recorded 18 points during the win.

* Junior guard **Sarah Gehring**, senior guard **Dani Dudek** and sophomore forward **Cindy Hassler** all scored in double figures for Stevens. Gehring was four of 10 from the field for 12 points as she totaled seven rebounds. Dudek registered her eighth double-double of the season on 11 points and 12 boards. She was two assists shy of making it her sixth career triple-double. Hassler finished with 11 points on four of seven shooting.

* The NCAA recently publicized its seventh national ranking summary for women's basketball, and senior guard **Dani Dudek** is currently fourth in the country in assists per game with a 7.2 average through 20 games played. Dudek is also 23rd in assist-turnover ratio (1.95) and 40th in field-goal percentage (52.7). The Ducks are ranked in nine statistical team categories as well.

* As a team, the Ducks are ranked in the Top-50 for scoring margin (16th - 17.4), field-goal percentage (18th - 44.4), field-goal percentage defense (4th - 31.5), win-loss percentage (26th - 53.0), assists per game (25th - 16.6), assist turnover ratio (7th - 1.08), rebound margin (41st - 6.8), scoring defense (26th - 85.0) and three-point field-goal defense (23rd - 25.0).

* Stevens will return to action tonight against Ithaca College at 6 p.m. in Ithaca, N.Y.

MEN'S FENCING

Overall record14-10

* The Stevens Institute of Technology men's fencing team competed at the New Jersey Institute of Technology Invitational on Sunday in Newark, N.J. and the Ducks posted an impressive 6-1 showing to improve to 14-10 on the year.

* Stevens defeated Yeshiva University 25-2, Lafayette College 22-5, Rutgers University 19-8, Maryland University 22-5, Saint John's College 20-2 and Hunter College 25-2. The only loss came against Drew University in a tight, 12-15 decision.

* The invite closes out regular season team competition for the Ducks as they look forward to individual action starting with the Junior Olympics this coming weekend. Stevens will send some of its fencers to Albuquerque, N.M. to compete in the prestigious event in preparation for the Middle Atlantic Collegiate Fencing Association Championships the following weekend.

* At the NJIT invitational, the Ducks received strong performances from its dominant foilists, seniors **Ben Hochberg** and **Lowden Charles**. First-year standouts **David Gordon** and **Dzimitry Lamianski** had fine outings in the sabre division for Stevens.

WOMEN'S FENCING

Overall record14-3

* Senior epeeist **Rachel Cannell** posted a 12-2 outing to help the Stevens Institute of Technology women's fencing team to a 3-2 day at the 2009 Stevens Invitational in Hoboken, N.J. on Sunday.

* The epee squad finished 27-18 at today's event, including impressive wins over Brandeis University and Farleigh Dickinson University as the Ducks improve to 14-3 on the year. In the 35-year history of women's fencing at Stevens, there has been just four other seasons that head coach **Linda Vollkommer-Lynch** has surpassed the 13-win mark in a season.

* The Ducks tallied wins against FDU (18-9), Queens College (20-7) and Hunter College (17-10), while Stevens fell to Temple University (3-24) and Brandeis (8-19). Arguably one of the best epee squads in all of Division III, the Judges of Brandeis felt the wrath of the Ducks as the epee team took down Brandeis 5-4. Stevens' epee squad also posted a flawless 9-0 ledger against Hunter, which assisted in the Ducks third victory of the day.

* Sophomore epeeist **Meagan Ritter** finished 9-5 on the day, while in foil, senior **Khairun Nisa Aziz** and junior **Danielle Bisson** registered records of 6-8 and 6-7, respectively. Finally, the sabre division was led by senior **Laura Sodon** and freshman **Krista Sticco**. Sodon carded a 7-8 mark on the day as Sticco posted a 6-7 performance.

* Special recognition goes out to a pair of talented seniors that have made their mark on the Stevens women's fencing program in more ways than dominating on the strips. Captains **Laura Sodon** and **Rachel Cannell** have provided solid leadership and helped to instill the great tradition of fencing that has been built over the years. Cannell has moved into second all-time for most wins by an epee fencer at Stevens. Sodon recently surpassed the 100-career win-plateau to stand as the all-time leader at Stevens for wins in the sabre division.

Women's Indoor Track & Field

* The Stevens Institute of Technology women's indoor track and field team competed at the New Balance Invitational on Friday and Saturday. Stevens broke two school-records and also had a first in the history of the program. A total of 130 colleges and universities from around the country came to the Armory Track and Field Center in New York, N.Y., with over 85 percent of the participants coming from NCAA Division I schools.

* The Stevens distance medley relay team carded a 13:01.13 in finishing 10th-place overall and demolished the previous school-record of 13:27.07 set on January 16 at the Gotham Invitational. The team of sophomore **Shanna Beairsto**, seniors **Hillary Paul** and **Salme Cook**, and junior **Melissa Franzese** become the first-ever Stevens relay team to qualify for the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference Indoor Championships.

* Cook broke the previous school-record in the 800-meter run, finishing with a 2:28.72. She beat Beairsto's former school-best by .07. In the 5000-meter run, Franzese carded a lifetime personal-best time of 18:48.42 (second all-time at Stevens).

* "This was a very high caliber meet with many of the premier Division I programs in America in attendance," Head Coach **John Crawford** (Seattle, Wash.) said. "It was great for our athletes to compete at the highest level, and it resulted in some strong times for our teams."

* On Monday, the conference office named **Salme Cook** the Empire 8 Women's Indoor Track and Field Athlete of Week for her performance at the New Balance Invite.

* Stevens will return to competitive action February 13 and 14 at the Collegiate Track Conference Championships in New Haven, Conn.

The senior broke the tape at 50.90, good for second in Stevens history.

* The distance medley relay team turned in a 10:51.59. Freshman **Sean Vasquez** ran the 1200-meter leg in 3:17.60, junior **Kevin Morgera** ran the 400 in 51.20, freshman **Drew Ballinger** turned in a 2:05.40 in the 800, and sophomore **Bradford Antes** finished the 1,600 in 4:36.40.

* Vasquez also turned in the fifth-best time in Stevens history with a 2:00.50 in the 800-meter run.

* "This was a very high caliber meet with many of the premier Division I programs in America in attendance," Head Coach **John Crawford** said. "It was great for our athletes to compete at the highest level, and it resulted in some strong times for our guys."

* Stevens will return to competitive action February 13 and 14 at the Collegiate Track Conference Championships in New Haven, Conn.

* The Stevens Institute of Technology wrestling team fell to No. 25 Lycoming College on Wednesday evening in Williamsport, Pa. Stevens got wins from four of its 10 wrestlers, and junior 157-pounder **Leo Dormann** won his 14th-straight bout. The loss drops the Ducks to 10-8 on the season as they will get a week to rest prior to their final Centennial Conference weekend of the season.

* The Stevens wins came from junior heavyweight **James Roarty**, senior 197-pounder **Valentin Riazanov**, freshman 174-pounder **Ryan Dormann**, and **Leo Dormann**.

* Lycoming won the first four bouts of the match earning a major decision, a technical fall, a pin and a decision at 125, 133, 141, and 149, respectively.

* **Leo Dormann**, who has beaten his last 10 opponents in dual-match competition, won a thrilling, 12-10 decision over Zachary Frederick (West Chester, Pa.). The two were knotted at the end of three periods and Dormann earned a takedown early in the sudden-death overtime to score the win and get the Ducks on the board.

* Freshman **Joe Favia** wrestled extremely tough against tenth-ranked Chris Dalheimer (Felton, Pa.), falling 1-0 at 165 lbs. **Ryan Dormann** got the second win of the day in the 174-lb. weight class with a 3-0 decision and Riazanov earned a decision over Bryan Kopesky (Phillipsburg, N.J.). Stevens' final win came from Roarty at 285 lbs. as he too earned a 4-0 decision over Rick Ausem (Towanda, Pa.).

* The Ducks will return to competitive action on February 14 at Gettysburg College. They will face Gettysburg and Johns Hopkins University.
