In 2008-09, Trevor Miele completed his third season as the head men and women's swimming coach at Stevens Institute of Technology. Over the course of his first three years with the Ducks, Miele has revitalized both of the programs and has Stevens on track to

becoming one of the top teams in the region and nation.

In 2008, the team placed 11th in the nation at NCAA Championships and eight swimmers were named NCAA All-Americans. Miele's teams have rewritten the record books. In fact, Ducks have broken 36 of a possible 38 school records this season.
