Stevens hosts "Count Me In" in celebration of National Girls and Women in Sports Day

On Saturday, February 18, Stevens Institute of Technology hosted "Count Me In," in celebration of National Girls and Women in Sports Day (NGWSD). More than 20 children, both male and female, ages 5 to 12, and their families, attended the event.

Participants attended the 1:00 pm women's basketball game, where the Ducks defeated St. Joseph's College 61-34. During the game, the children were able to get their faces painted, eat free food, and cheer on the ducks. During half-time, participants competed in a relay race to be the first to dress as a Stevens basketball player and dribble across the court.



After the game, the women's basketball team led a 45-minute basketball clinic, where the children participated in relay races and

games like knockout. The basketball clinic was followed by an interactive fencing demonstration, where the women's fencing team showed off their skills. Two children were given the opportunity to dress in full garb and bout in front of the other participants.
